Safety Courses

Five-Hour Pre-Licensing Course for New Drivers

The DMV now mandates completion of a five-hour pre-licensing course prior to taking the road test. Participants will earn a pre-licensing course certificate, MV-278, after the completion of this course. This certificate number will be required when scheduling a road test. The New York State Five-Hour Pre-licensing course covers the following driving fundamentals:

- The DMV point system
- The highway transportation system
- The laws of physics as they relate to driving and the effects of restraining devices
- Defensive driving techniques
- What to do in case of a collision
- The effects of driver attitude, emotions, and skills
- Alcohol and drugs, and their effects on driving

Participants must bring a valid NYS Learner's Permit to class. State paperwork will be signed at the end of class.

Creative Courses

Beginner Crocheting

Participants will learn the basics of crocheting and have the opportunity to complete one project. Topics covered will include: basic crochet stitches, starting and ending a project, switching colors, and learning to read a pattern. The instructor will provide free project sheets. Participants are required to provide their own yarn, crochet hooks, and yarn needle. Please bring crochet hook size I, and on skein of 4-ply yarn (Red Heart works best for beginners) to begin hands on learning in the first class.

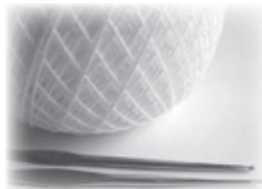

Ceramics

Participants will learn to work with the four basic methods of ceramic productions in this six-week course, including slab, coil, molding, and throwing. Participants will produce a variety of ceramic pieces fired and glazed. This course is for beginners to advanced participants.
